We are working with various states across America and participating in their licensing programs and are offering Continuing Education Classes to maintain your license.

Class “C” Apprenticeship

Upon completion of this course the student will have basic understanding of electrical theory, reading schematics, motor theory, control methodology, ANSI requirements, ASME requirements, Mechanical adjustments of Construction Personnel Hoists and Maintenance/Inspection of construction personnel hoists.

Class “B” Technician

After completing Class “C” training, 3000hrs of field experience, and attending an qualified OSHA 10 class the apprentice can then attend a Class “B” Course. Upon completion of this course the student will have in-depth understanding of electrical theory, reading schematics, motor theory, control methodology, ANSI requirements, ASME requirements, Mechanical adjustments of Construction Personnel Hoists and Maintenance/Inspection of construction personnel hoists. A Class “B” Technician will be qualified to supervise up to two apprentices on a job from start to finish.



Class “A” Technician

After completing Class “B” training, an additional 3000hrs of field experience, and attending an qualified OSHA 30 class the technician can then attend a Class “A” Course. Upon completion of this course the student will have in-depth understanding of electrical theory and application, reading schematics, motor theory and application, control methodology and application, a working knowledge of ANSI requirements, a working knowledge of ASME requirements, Mechanical adjustments of Construction Personnel Hoists and Maintenance/Inspection of construction personnel hoists, and Mechanical adjustments/Inspection of tower cranes. A Class “A” Technician will be qualified to supervise multiple jobsites from start to finish.

We offer training for the tower cranes and personnel hoist which we sell.

Continued Education

We offer refresher course for ANSI and OSHA standards as the apply to Personnel Hoists.
